The meeting was called to order at 2:32 p.m. by Dr. Christensen. Roll call of the committee members was taken and a quorum was established.

III. NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULEMAKING ("NPR")

The Committee began the review of A.A.C. R4-11-1301(Q) relating to General Anesthesia and Deep Sedation. The Committee discussed the qualifications for the two additional persons that shall be present with the patient during the critical portion of a procedure and ultimately tabled further discussion of the matter to a future meeting.

The Committee proceeded to add a section to have a designated person whose primary responsibility is to monitor the patient during the procedure.

Dr. Jerman departed the meeting at 3:55 p.m.

The Committee proceeded to clarify that a Section 1301 permit holder shall ensure a person monitors the patient until the patient meets criteria for discharge using a recognized pediatric discharge scoring system.

The Committee proceeded to review A.A.C. R4-11-1302 relating to Moderate Sedation and concurred to streamline language and not include the route of admission. Ms. Adams stated that the Board recently adopted a substantive policy statement relating to the renewal of sedation permits and commented that it may be beneficial for the Committee to review. Ms. Thomas subsequently suggested incorporating the substantive policy statement into the draft NPR.

Mr. Baghai departed the meeting at 4:30 p.m.
