NOTICE OF MEETING OF THE ARIZONA STATE BOARD OF DENTAL EXAMINERS’ ANESTHESIA AND SEDATION COMMITTEE

Pursuant to Arizona Revised Statute (“A.R.S”) § 38-431.02, notice is hereby given to the members of the Arizona State Board of Dental Examiners’ (“Board”) **Anesthesia and Sedation Committee** (“Committee”) and to the general public that the Committee will hold a meeting open to the public on **Tuesday, January 24, 2023 at 2:30 p.m.** The meeting will be held in virtual and telephonic formats. However, during the course of the meeting, the Committee, upon a majority vote of a quorum of the members, may, when necessary, hold an executive session pursuant to A.R.S. § 38-431.03(A)(2) and/or (3) as indicated on the Committee’s Agenda. The executive session is not open to the public.

The Committee Agenda is subject to change up to 24 hours prior to the meeting. Agenda items are noted by number and letter for convenience and reference. The Committee reserves the right to change the order of the agenda items, except for matters set for a specific time.
